- People need things to do

Hypnotoad's Wish List

- A series of inter-related projects
- I have already done a zero-th order approximation on many
- But I'm much more interested in getting other people to dive in and make it their own





Object Oriented Library for Tcl (TOOL)

- Revamp the Tcl Standard Library
- Redesign key packages to exploit coroutines and TclOO
- Provide a sensible template for OTHER frameworks
 - Documentation
 - Installation
 - Distribution

TOOL for Websockets

- HTTP Application Server
- SCGI Application Server
- Applications
 - Revamp the TIP system
 - A website to coordinate these projects

TOOL for Tk

- Further develop a standard megawidget framework in TcIOO
- Include ready to use items like:
 - Interactive Console
 - Interactive Help Viewer

TOOL for Canvas

- A library of layouts and abstractions for advanced Canvas animations
- A tool to develop an interactive Graphviz-like visualizer for Canvas
- Integrate a geometric constraints manager
- Accelerate basic vector and geometry routines in C

TOOL Shed

- Use Tcl to build Tcl C extensions
 - Death to Autoconf
 - Death to Make
- Provide tools for wrapping packages and executables
- tclConfig.tcl / tkConfig.tcl ?

ZipVFS In the Core

- Patches are already in a branch
- Zip encode/decode is in Tcllib
- Enhancements need to be migrated from AndroWish to allow for properly signed APK packages

Tcl for Kids

- A standard suite of tutorials that launch in a shrink-wrapped executable
 - (Remember that interactive console?)
- Ships with a TclTutor updated to 8.6
- Also includes games which require Tcl programming to solve
- Have a printed manual that can be sold in stores with the executable on CD
- Especially need help in supporting multiple languages

Project ... People

Tcl is a volunteer organization

- We just happen to build software
- Volunteer organizations need people to run
- Volunteer organizations also need funds to run

Tcl as a Social Organization

- We need to preserve the Annual Tcl Conference
- We also need:
 - "Mini" conferences held locally where we have clusters of Tclers
 - Could be part of other Tech meetups or get-together
 - But mostly we need to find ways for other people to discover Tcl

Tcl Actually needs employees

- "I'm bored, I need something to do"
 - Spoken by no Tcl programmer, ever
- Community building requires skill sets beyond programming
- They also require a great deal of work that would distract our programming talent programming

Tcl Pamphleteer

- Tcl Needs a singular source of good information
 - Product announcements
 - Project updates
 - People highlights
- Act as a non-geek to review documentation

Tcl Evangelist

- A salesman for Tcl
- Attend technology conferences
 - Especially running a Tcl community booth
- Do outlandish things to get in the news
- Be "that guy" who gets interviewed on NPR

Tcl Monk

- Maintain and curate dedicated technical resources for the community
 - The main website
 - Dedicated hosting for fossil repositories
 - Hosting for the Tcl projects board, the online newsletter, etc.

Tcl Clerk

- Someone to deal with finances
 - Tax paperwork
 - Taking receivership of monetary donations
 - Tracking Community owned properties

Tcl as a Social Club / Tech Cult / etc

- The community needs a dependable stream of revenue
- Conference attendance varies
 - Many want to attend, but can't

Tcl as a Social Club / Tech Cult / etc

- Many organizations have paid memberships
- Especially important:
 - Membership levels
 - Definable benefits conferred with Membership
